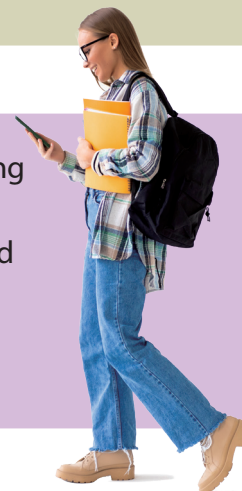

Thinking Starts Here

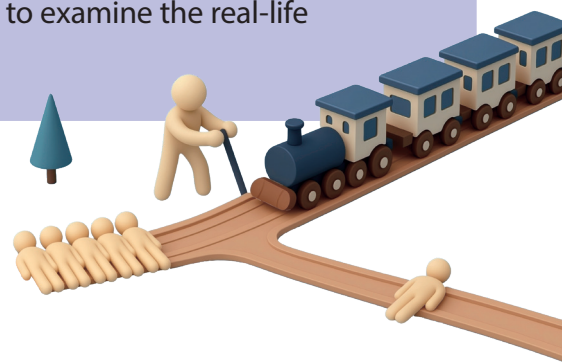
