
LEARNING OVERVIEW

Hostel

Hostels aren't as comfortable as hotels. They don't have swimming pools and nice restaurants. Most of the time, you have to share a room or bathroom. However, they are much cheaper than hotels. Bed and Breakfast (B&B)

Airbnb

Airbnb is one of the most popular forms of travel accommodation today. Using the Airbnb website or mobile app, a host can list their property. Then, travelers can book whichever property catches their eye. The properties can be single rooms, apartments, houseboats, or even castles! Airbnb properties oftentimes offer better amenities



than hotels, such as full kitchens, bicycles, kayaks, pools, and more. This modern hospitality service could be your ticket to a great vacation.
